



HRPA Chapter Innovation Award - 2011

Overview

The HRP A Innovation Award is presented in recognition of a winning Chapter whose innovative program or initiative best supports its membership and success of the Chapter during the relevant membership year.

Award Criteria:

A detailed submission outlining how the Chapter has met the three award criteria; please format your submission to provide specific examples under each of the three criteria.

1. Must be a NEW innovative Chapter program or initiative that was in the relevant specified membership year – see application form (points 35/100);
2. Must focus on how the program or initiative has contributed to the success of the HRP A and how HRP A members have benefitted (points 35/100).
3. Must provide an overview of the strategy, implementation and outcome details (points 30/100);

Submission Requirements:

Applications must be submitted by the Chapter President, Chapter committee chair or their designate, and must reflect information for accomplishments in the membership year specified on the application form.

Award Entitlements:

- Award presented by CEO and Board Chair at the 2011 HRP A Volunteer & Leadership Awards ceremony.
- One nights paid accommodation for recipient (at HRP A designated hotel) and travel to and from the event (in accordance with HRP A's travel expense policy, and inclusive of any scheduled Chapter President's meeting)
- One awards event pass for a guest of the recipient
- Four complimentary passes for the next available annual conference (non transferrable)
- Inclusion of innovative practices information in HRP A's online Chapter Management Centre
- Inclusion in any editorial coverage on awards
